SOME OF OUR IMPACTS

ASCCA has a rich history of advocating for the auto repair industry. From influencing legislation to fighting damaging lawsuits, ASCCA is at the forefront of driving positive change. ASCCA members have successfully, through grassroots campaigns, been an active voice for the future of auto repair in California. Some of our key impacts include:

- Simplifying modern vehicle diagnostics by being a **part of the design team that created the OBDII connector.**
- Successfully **fought for and won legislation (SB1146) that created the first "Right to Repair" act in the nation.**
- **Successfully fought for the elimination of damaging, frivolous lawsuits** (Trevor Law Group) that tried to extort money from automotive shop owners.
- ASCCA **successfully opposed legislation (AB 2454) that would have created a state mandated "grading system,"** similar to restaurants.

- ASCCA members **fought and defeated SB 750 – the key code lock out bill** that would have excluded independent shop owners' access to vehicle communications.
- ASCCA **fought for and defeated legislation (SB 993), which would have extended sales taxes to vehicle repair labor services,** and unnecessarily increased repair costs.
- ASCCA **defeated legislation (AB 2825), which would have treated auto repair businesses as "debt collectors."** making all communications with customers subject to fines and frivolous lawsuits.
- ASCCA **opposed and defeated legislation (AB 755), which would have increased the current \$1.75 tire tax fee to \$3.25 per tire.**
- ASCCA **helped pass legislation (AB 3141) to include all unlicensed automotive maintenance service providers** and other previously exempted repairers under BAR jurisdiction to create a level playing field.
- ASCCA **helped pass BAR regulations to allow auto repair shops to provide customers with electronic estimates and authorizations** (e.g. text messages).
